
Activities undertaken by NCC Cell of R.S. Girls' College Session 2022 – 23

A. Observance of World Environment Day on 5th June, 2022

NCC unit of Rabindrasadan Girls' College, Karimganj has observed World Environment Day on 5th June, 2022 with great enthusiasm and spirit. Huge number of cadets was present on that day and participated in various activities in spite of heavy rainfall and waterlogging in various parts of the Karimganj town. The main activities undertaken by the unit on the occasion of World Environment Day under the guidance of CTO Dr. Tapasi Sinha are –

Essay competition – as a part of the observation an Essay competition on the theme "Only One Earth" was organized on 4th June by the NCC Cell of the college. Large number of cadets and students of the college participated in that competition making it a great success.

Cleanliness Drive – a major cleanliness drive of both indoor and outdoor of the college campus was undertaken on that day at 9.30 A.M onwards. At first different classrooms of the college were cleaned and thereafter college playground, entrance of the college and footpath in front of the college were cleaned.













Plantation – after the cleanliness drive, plantation of saplings was done inside the campus. Due to the lack of space inside the campus plantation was limited to three saplings only.

The Rally started from the college and marched towards Kalibari Road, Santar Bazar, Station Road, Police point and back to the college via old station Road. NCC cadets participated in the Rally by holding Banners, Play cards and sapling in their hands. The main objective of the Rally was to convey important messages regarding the conservation and protection of our environment and mother Earth. Some of the important slogan written in the placards are "Clean Karimganj Green Karimganj", "#Only One Earth", "If not Today we will repent later, so let's protect the world and biodiversity", "Save Water, Save Environment" etc. all in all the event was very successful and comes to an end by serving snacks to all the participants.

Girls' college has undertaken a Motivational Program on the theme "Har Ghar Tiranga to create awareness among the teachers and students to unflur tricolor from 13th to 15th august. In this connection the NCC cadets under the guidance of CTO Dr. Tapasi Sinha demonstrates the proper process of folding the tricolor. Besides, they have also prepared a short act entitled "unity in Diversity" to accelerate the spirit of nationalism among the teachers and students. They also performed patriotic dance and song. The chief guest of the program was Dr. Arun Roy, obstetrician & Gynaecologist, IMS Hospital Karimganj and also President of the organisation 'Freedom'. The celebration started with the welcome address given by CTO Dr. Tapasi Sinha of Rabindrasadan Girl's college. She primarily focused on the historical background of international women's day and also briefly highlighted about the theme of the year which is embrace equity. After her welcome address, Dr. Memchaton Singha, Asstt. Secretory of ACTA Women Cell, Karimganj & Hailakandi zone delivered her keynote address. 





MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)FOR ACADEMIC EXCHANGES AND CO-OPERATION BETWEEN



NILAMBAZAR COLLEGE, NILAMBAZAR AND RABINDRASADAN GIRLS' COLLEGE, KARIMGANJ

This memorandum of understanding (MoU) is made between Nilambazar College, Nilambazar, Karimganj, Assam, affiliated to Assam University, Silchar, established on 14th July, 1994 and provincialised in 2013 by the Govt. of Assam, in some steps as amended upto date, having its office at Nilambazar, herein after called NBC, N.

And

Rabindrasadan Girls' College, Karimganj, Assam, affiliated to Assam University, Silchar, established in 1962 and provincialised by the Govt. of Assam, in some steps as amended upto date, having its office at Karimganj, herein after called Rabindrasadan Girls' College, Karimganj.

In order to promote co-operation and advancement of research, teaching and academic exchanges between Nilambazar College, Nilambazar and Rabindrasadan Girls' College, Karimganj the two institutions agree to formalize a MoU as follows:

- 1. Based on the principles of mutual benefits and respect for each other's independence, the two institutions will foster:
 - A) Visiting each institution as part of KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGES
 - B) EXCHANGE OF SPORTS ACTIVITIES
 - C) EXCHANGE OF ACADEMIC MATERIALS (library books, computers etc.)
 - D) ORGANIZING SHORT TERM PROGRAMMES (Seminars/Debates etc.)
 - E) EXCHANGE OF CULTURAL ACTIVITIES
- 2. In order to carry out the above activities, detailed plans may be prepared jointly by the IQAC of both institutions.
- 3. In the interest of expanding educational opportunities, both the colleges agree to facilitate exchange program as under:

A. KNOWLEDGE EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The knowledge exchange program shall be administered through the IQAC of both institutions.

B. EXCHANGE OF SPORTS ACTIVITIES

In principle, each institution may send at least 3 (three) students (one from each faculty, if available) from UG classes.

i. Student Program Fees/benefits to host institution:

There shall be any fees payable to host institution. Additional benefits for the knowledge exchange and other activities may be provided by mutual agreement if the host institution agrees to help exchange activities by providing suitable accommodation to the students. All meal, accommodation and travel cost will be borne by the individual students.

ii. The Indemnity:

Each participant should submit indemnity bond, health certificate and risk certificate duly countersigned by their parents.

iii. Student Eligibility:

The obligation of each institution will be to designate meritorious students for participation in the program. There should be a letter of recommendation and certified bio-data from the home institution.

C. EXCHANGE OF ACADEMIC MATERIALS (library books, computers etc.)

The IQAC of both the institutions will be administrative body to fix all details about such exchanges.

D. ORGANIZING SHORT TERM PROGRAM

Each institution will encourage different departments to organize joint program such as seminars, conferences, workshop, FDP etc.

E. EXCHANGE OF CULTURAL ACTIVITIES

Both the institution makes effort for promotions of values and cultures through cultural exchange.

*Evaluation and Certification

The host institution will evaluate the individual participants in the exchange programme and arrange certificates to participants.

*Validity of MoU

This MoU will remain in force for three (03) years after which it may be extended on yearly basis, if both the college mutually agree.

The agreement shall be effective on and after the date of signing by the Head of the Institutions and remain in force for three (03) years or the date on which either party wishes to terminate during that period. In order to terminate a written notice of thirty days shall have to be served showing reason of termination.

This MoU will be modified subject to the recommendation of IQAC of both the institutions.

Each party shall keep confidential any information that it receives from the other party under confidential cover or which a party notified the other party as confidential.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective on and from 26.10.2022.
